The Iowa PTA is pleased about your interest in applying for a scholarship from the Iowa PTA Scholarship Fund. The fund was established in 1974 in memory of Mr. H. L. Taylor, husband of Neva Taylor, past Executive Secretary for the Iowa PTA. The purpose is to help recipients accomplish their diverse educational goals.

You are eligible to apply for the scholarship if you are a public high school senior <u>and</u> there is currently an active PTA in your school district. This would include an elementary, middle school, junior high or a senior high school PTA.

If you are selected to receive a scholarship from Iowa PTA, you will be invited to attend an awards ceremony at the Iowa PTA Convention.

It is very important to follow directions carefully and submit your application on time. Your application and <u>all</u> pertinent information should be sent to <u>info@iowapta.org</u> with the subject line *Iowa PTA Scholarship* by February 1<sup>st</sup>. Some excellent candidates have been disqualified by not following directions. Please review the process carefully.

## Iowa PTA - H.L. Taylor Scholarship

# Deadline: February 1st

The H. L. Taylor Scholarship is a grant awarded to Iowa students to assist in post-secondary education. To be eligible for consideration, an individual must be a graduating senior of an Iowa public high school (or equivalent of an accredited lowa public institution) and be considered a resident of the state of Iowa for one year prior to graduation. The student's high school must be in a school district that has a PTA within the district. The scholarship must be used for full-time study at an accredited Iowa college or university, Iowa area vocational school, or other post high school training institution. Students attending institutions that train for specific professions are considered eligible as long as the institutions are licensed by the state of Iowa and have proper professional recognition. Applicants are not limited to any specific field.

Eligible persons may request applications from the Iowa PTA Office:

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The completed application, including personal letter, achievement example, and transcripts must be emailed to info@iowapta.org by February 1<sup>st</sup>. Winners will be notified by March 1<sup>st</sup>. Winners will be invited to attend a ceremony at the Iowa PTA Convention following the acceptance of the award.

## Grants awarded will not to exceed \$500 per individual.

Checks will be made payable to the institution the recipient has documented as their choice of school. The number of grants given each year and the amount awarded will be determined annually by the Scholarship Committee of the Iowa PTA.

Final selection will be made by a committee of five people, one of whom shall be a member of the Iowa PTA Leadership Team. Two of the five judges shall be educators or guidance counselors serving at either the high school or college level. Appointments to the Scholarship Committee are to be made by the President of the Iowa PTA.

#### Selection of recipients will be based on the following:

- 1. Financial need.
- 2. Academic record.
- Intention to enroll as a full-time student at any accredited lowa college or university, area vocational school or other post high school training.
- 4. <u>Student in a PTA school district</u>.
- 5. Potential for candidate in his/her chosen field.
- 6. References and complete application materials.
- 7. Involvement in extra-curricular and community activities.
- 8. PTA Parental involvement throughout student's school years.

Three letters of reference are required. Letters may come from, but are not limited to: teachers, principals, counselors, superintendents, community leaders and employers. Letters of reference must be emailed to the info@iowapta.org by February 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Candidates must attach a personal letter** giving a short biography and an explanation of why the candidate is applying for a scholarship. Information also must be included regarding why the candidate has selected their chosen vocation.

Candidate must attach one example of their ability in any field, i.e., an award in extracurricular activities, a project for academic classes or outside activities, a written assignment from a class (Please include copies only. These items will not be returned).

## Include high school transcript.

**Deadline: February 1st** 

Applicant must be a graduating senior of an lowa public high school <u>that has a PTA in the school district</u> and must be a resident of the state of lowa for one year prior to graduation. Applicant must be a PTA or PTSA member in lowa or be sponsored by a PTA member (parent, guardian, teacher or other PTA or PTSA member). The scholarship must be used for full-time study at an accredited lowa college, university, vocational school, or other post-secondary training institution. Students attending institutions that train for specific professions are considered eligible if the institutions are licensed by the state of lowa and have proper professional recognition. Awards will not exceed \$500. The number of grants given, and the amount will be determined annually by the IPTA Scholarship Committee. Selection is based upon financial need, academic record, candidate's potential to succeed in chosen field, references, extra-curricular involvement, community activities and parental PTA involvement.
